What is this product?

Type: Shares of a Sub-Fund of Amundi Funds, an Undertaking for Collective Investments in Transferable Securities (UCITS), established as a SICAV.

Term: The term of the Sub-Fund is unlimited. The Management Company may terminate the fund by liquidation or merger with another fund in accordance with legal requirements.

Objectives: To achieve a combination of income and capital growth (total return). The Sub-Fund invests at least 67% of net assets in investment-grade debt instruments that are denominated in US dollar, and at least 50% of net assets in investment-grade debt instruments issued by companies that are headquartered, or do substantial business, in the United States. Whilst the investment manager aims to invest in ESG Rated securities not all investments of the Sub-Fund will have an ESG rating and in any event such investments will not be more than 10% of the Sub-Fund. The Sub-Fund makes use of derivatives to reduce various risks, for efficient portfolio management and as a way to gain exposure (long or short) to various assets, markets or other investment opportunities (including derivatives which focus on credit, interest rates, and foreign exchange). The Sub-Fund may use credit derivatives (up to 40% of net assets). The Sub-Fund is actively managed by reference to and seeks to outperform the Bloomberg Capital US Corporate Index. The Sub-Fund is predominantly exposed to the issuers of the Benchmark, however, the management of the Sub-Fund is discretionary, and will be exposed to issuers not included in the Benchmark. The Sub-Fund monitors risk exposure in relation to the Benchmark and the extent of deviation from the Benchmark is expected to be significant. Further, the Sub-Fund has designated the benchmark as a reference benchmark for the purpose of the Disclosure Regulation. The Benchmark is a broad market index, which does not assess or include constituents according to environmental characteristics, and therefore is not aligned with the environmental characteristics promoted by the Sub-Fund. The investment team uses both technical and fundamental analysis to develop a list of individual securities that appear to be attractively valued and to offer the best risk-adjusted returns (bottom-up). The investment team also factors in analysis of economic and interest rate trends. The Sub-Fund seeks to achieve an ESG score of its portfolio greater than that of the Benchmark. When analysing ESG score against the Benchmark, the Sub-Fund is compared with the ESG score of its Benchmark after 20% of the lowest ESG rated securities have been excluded from the Benchmark.

Intended Retail Investor: This product is intended for investors, with a basic knowledge of and no or limited experience of investing in funds seeking to increase the value of their investment and to receive income over the recommended holding period with the ability to bear losses up to the amount invested.

Redemption and Dealing: Shares may be sold (redeemed) as stated in the prospectus at the respective dealing price (net asset value). Further details are provided in the Amundi Funds prospectus.

Distribution Policy: As this is a non-distributing share class, investment income is reinvested.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period: 3 years is based on our assessment of the risk and reward characteristics and costs of the Sub-Fund.

This product is designed for medium-term investment; you should be prepared to stay invested for at least 3 years. You can redeem your investment at any time, or hold the investment longer.

Order schedule: Orders to redeem shares must be received before 02:00 PM Luxembourg time on the Valuation Day. Please refer to the Amundi Funds Prospectus for further details regarding redemptions.

To manage liquidity risks and in the best interests of investors, should redemption requests exceed a predefined threshold, the sub-fund may restrict investors' redemption rights and process such requests only partially, on a pro rata basis. The functioning is further described in the prospectus.

To foster fair cost-allocation and mitigate dilution effects, in the best interests of investors, the sub-fund may use swing pricing, a pre-determined mechanism by which the net asset value of the units is adjusted by the application of a factor that reflects the cost of liquidity. The functioning is further described in the prospectus.

You may exchange shares of the Sub-Fund for shares of other sub-funds of Amundi Funds in accordance with the Amundi Funds prospectus.
